

# About Bebtelovimab and COVID-19

## What you need to know

Bebtelovimab may not work against some variants of the virus that causes COVID-19. These variants are now the most common in the United States, and in the Midwest.

We continue to offer bebtelovimab for patients at high risk of severe COVID-19 illness and who are not able to take other medications for COVID-19.

But if you have one of the most common variants, bebtelovimab may not keep you from getting very sick.

## What you need to do

Talk to your physician or advanced practice provider about other medications you may be able to take in addition to bebtelovimab.

Continue to monitor your symptoms.

Contact your care team if your symptoms get worse.

Go to the emergency department or call 911 if you develop serious symptoms, such as difficulty breathing or chest pain.
